

HumRRO Fellowship in Educational Measurement & Evaluation

Fellowship

The Human Resources Research Organization (HumRRO) is pleased to sponsor the HumRRO Fellowship in Educational Measurement and Evaluation in recognition of outstanding academic achievement and research promise. Launched in 2024, the fellowship awards a non-renewable \$18,000 stipend to a graduate student demonstrating exceptional research skills. The recipient will be required to progress satisfactorily toward completion of their dissertation and present their research during a visit to HumRRO. Additional opportunities to interact with HumRRO staff may be provided. The financial award will be distributed in two installments (September and December).

Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration, an applicant must be a doctoral candidate in educational measurement and evaluation or a closely related discipline whose dissertation topic has been proposed and approved. Since a purpose of the fellowship is to provide financial support while the student completes their dissertation, applicants should be actively involved in the process of completing their dissertation research but not finished nor near completion at the time of application.

Selection

Applicants will be evaluated based on their research promise, academic achievement, and professional productivity. Finalists may be interviewed.

Application Process

Each applicant must provide HumRRO with the following materials on or before the deadline date:

- Completed application form
- Personal statement
- Three letters of recommendation
- Official transcript from each institution attended for graduate academic work
